While people lined up to buy her steamed bread, Zang Chaiyuan worked late into the night recently. She managed to mix modern elements into "Jiaodong huabobo", a popular traditional food.

Huabobo refers to a flower-shaped steamed bread, which has been a treat at local folk activities, such as celebrations and festivals.

Zang shaped huabobo by hand. And these shapes change from cute rabbits dressed in lion dance costumes to treasure bowls and lucky bags and so on.

Although her parents didn't agree on her work, she still kept making huabobo. "My grandmother was good at making this kind of food. They not only looked beautiful but also tasted good," Zang recalls. She then set her sights on huabobo at the beginning of 2020. At first, she learned from an experienced huabobo master about the basic skills and then practiced over and over on her own. It didn't take long before Zang got the whole process down to a fine art.

Later, Zang opened her small huabobo shop in Yantai. Many of her followers came to buy her huabobo and praised that they were too cute to be eaten.

Now different kinds of huabobo, from beautiful flowers to cute animals, get popular. They symbolize beautiful life and good luck.

"Many people have shown great interest in the huabobo skills," she says. "I love traditional Chinese culture and I believe that this artwork is spreading around the world."

Though oceans cover about 71 percent of the earth's surface, there's still a lot we don't know about them. Only about 20 percent of the seafloor has been mapped, and the remaining 80 percent is still a secret to us. Some scientists even think that 91 percent of sea animals have yet to be discovered.

So why do we know so little about the deep sea? Well, getting to those depths is very difficult and requires high technology that simply didn't come into being for most of human history. The first navigable submarine(可驾驶的潜水艇), for example, was built in 1620, and it couldn't go more than five meters below the surface. In fact, for a long time many scientists didn't even think that there could be any life at depths greater than 550 meters and didn't see much need to explore the deep sea. However, this changed in 1862 when life was discovered as far down as 945 meters below sea level with the help of a digging machine. Ten years later, around 4,700 species(物种) unknown before from the ocean floor were discovered.

Since then, high technology has been developed to help explore the deep sea, including satellites. But why is deep-sea exploration still so difficult? Well, at greater depths it is freezing, and everything is completely dark, and the pressure can be over 1,000 times greater than that on the surface. Though we have the difficulties, it's important that we understand the seas. **They** help control the earth's temperature and produce half of the oxygen (O<sub>2</sub>) in the air. They can also provide us with information about climate change. Our future depends on learning more about our oceans, and it is possible for us to really understand what is ongoing below the surface.
