A cold gives you a runny nose and cough. But it's usually easy to deal with. Some take medicine while others drink herbal (花草) tea or chicken soup. Usually you feel better after a week.

On the other hand, the flu can be much more dangerous. It usually gives you fever. Sometimes it can cause death. According to an American magazine, the worst flu killed about 50 million people from 1918 to 1919.

Don't worry. If you get a flu vaccine (疫苗), it can protect you from getting the virus. Flu vaccines work by giving the body a small amount of flu viruses. This causes your body to develop antibodies (抗体). So next time you get the flu, the antibodies should help you.

The flu virus changes every few years. The antibodies for one type of flu can't help us against all types of flu. That's why we need to get the vaccine every year.

However, good health habits may also help protect you from catching a cold or flu. Washing your hands often helps stop you from getting viruses. It is also important to get regular exercise and eat healthy food. All these can help you strengthen your immune system (免疫系统).
